On September 22, Brother Andrew, Dutch missionary and founder of Open Doors, made his final voyage to his heavenly reward at the age of 94. Known for his intrepid commitment to getting God's Word behind

the Iron Curtain into communist nations during the Cold War, "God's Smuggler" repeatedly trekked to spiritually dark places with convictions like, "Don't curse the darkness, but light a candle," and, "You can get in anywhere if you go to serve."

Also from the Netherlands, Corrie ten Boom, authored the celebrated biography, *The Hiding Place*, which recounts how her family was arrested and sent to Nazi concentration camps for hiding and sheltering Jews during WWII. Later, she went on to become a world renown Christian writer, public speaker, and selfproclaimed "tramp for the Lord," as she traipsed the world pointing people to forgiveness found in Christ

with the message that, "There is no pit so deep, that God's love is not deeper still."

As we strive to emulate the lives of these two aforementioned saints, we are so grateful to have been sent to represent the "Light of Life" in an increasingly secular Europe where millions have yet to have an adequate witness of Jesus.
