
- New students to find faith in Christ

- ◆ A regular total attendance of approximately 150 students



- An annual missions trip to instill the need to not only receive help but to go and give the good news in other lands
 - ♦ Italy (2003)
 - ♦ Scotland (2004)
 - ♦ Louisiana, USA (2004)
 - ♦ Hungary (2005)
 - ♦ Greece (2006)
 - ♦ Belgium Flemish region (2007)
- ◆ The establishment of *SFC-Belgium* as an official government-recognized non-profit organization (2003)
- ◆ The creation of "Les Amis de SFC," a financial support structure of alumni and friends who believe in the self-funding concept of the ministry
- ◆ The hosting of nine Missionary Associate singles/couples to assist in the student ministry (our tenth MA couple is arriving later in 2007)
- Participation and helping in the organization of an annual all-Europe SFC campus ministry training conference in Brussels
- ♦ Networking internationally with other francophone student associations in France and Reunion Island
- Pre-marital counseling, as a natural result of relationships with students as they embark on the next phase of their lives
- ◆ Implementation this fall 2007 of a campus-missionary-intraining internship promoting the concept of a self-governing and self-propagating ministry
